DESCRIPTION

The accommodation is arranged over two floors and comprises a spacious lounge/diner with a bay window to the front, feature fireplace and a staircase rises to the first floor. From the lounge/diner, a door leads to a useful utility space and fitted kitchen, which has a range of wall and base units with space for appliances. A door from here leads to the garden. To the first floor there are three bedrooms and a bathroom. The main bedroom enjoys views across the village.





