


This home is situated in the heart of Gerrards Cross's prestigious Dukes Wood estate and has been comprehensively renovated by the current owners. It boasts underfloor heating across the entire ground floor, an updated central heating system with two boilers and a Megaflo system, ensuring excellent water pressure and efficient heating throughout the home.

Upon entering the property, you are welcomed by a spacious entrance hall accessed via impressive double doors, setting the tone for the generous accommodation found throughout. The main reception room is a particularly large and inviting space, enhanced by rear-aspect bifold doors that open directly onto the garden, allowing natural light to flood the room while creating seamless indoor-outdoor living. The heart of the home is the impressive kitchen/dining room, thoughtfully designed for both everyday family life and hosting. The kitchen features granite work surfaces and a large central island with breakfast bar seating. Integrated appliances include a Siemens oven and microwave, along with two fridge freezers and a built-in wine cooler. Cooking facilities comprise a combination of a two-ring gas hob and a four-ring induction hob beneath a ceiling-mounted extractor, a double sink with food disposer, and an instant hot water tap. French doors open onto the rear patio, allowing a natural flow between the kitchen and garden. Additional ground floor accommodation includes a front-aspect reception room which works perfectly as a snug or secondary sitting room, as well as a generous study with built-in storage and internal access to the garage. A well-appointed utility room features a sink, washer and dryer, an additional fridge freezer, and extensive storage space. A conveniently located WC with a window and extraction completes the ground floor.

The first floor hosts four well-proportioned bedrooms and a contemporary family bathroom featuring a large walk-in shower with a rainfall shower head. The principal bedroom is particularly impressive, with large picture windows, a walk-in dressing room, and an en-suite bathroom complete with a bathtub. Bedroom two is a large rear-aspect double with its own dressing room and en-suite featuring a rainfall shower. Bedroom three also benefits from integrated storage and a spacious en-suite shower room, while bedroom six is another generous double with built-in storage.

The second floor has two additional bedrooms. Bedroom four is a large room with two windows and an additional snug or seating area, while bedroom five is a spacious dual-aspect double incorporating a Velux window and integrated storage. A stylish bathroom serves this level and features a freestanding bath, walk-in rainfall shower, and an anti-mist mirror.

Externally, the property enjoys a well-maintained rear garden with a full-length patio area, ideal for outdoor dining and entertaining, complete with external power sockets. The lawn is bordered by mature hedging, creating a good degree of privacy, and benefits from an automatic golf course-style irrigation system. There are also two useful outbuildings, including a large shed with a recently replaced roof and a further storage shed. The single garage also benefits from an electric car charger.


