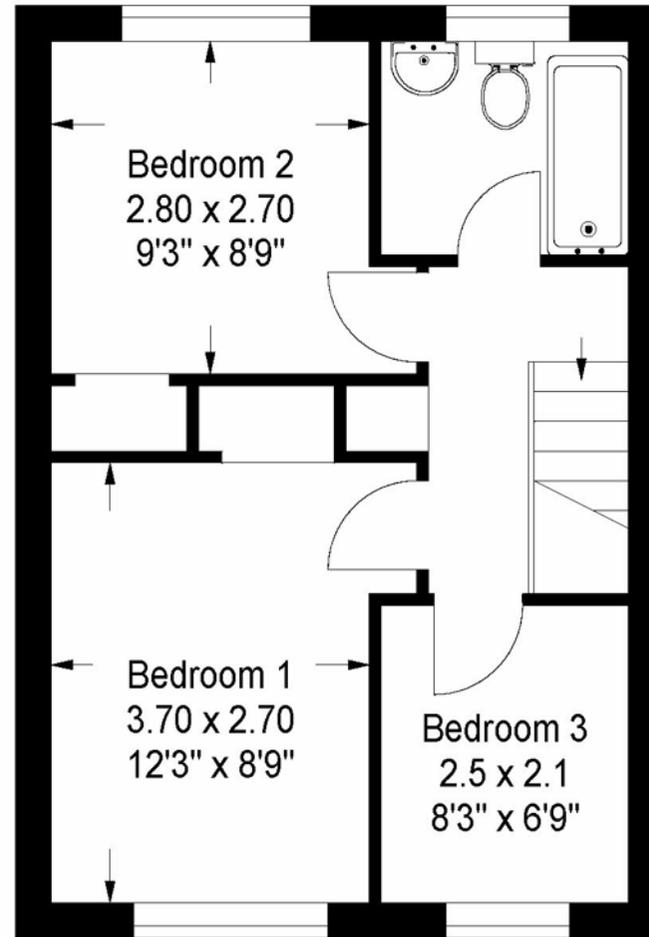
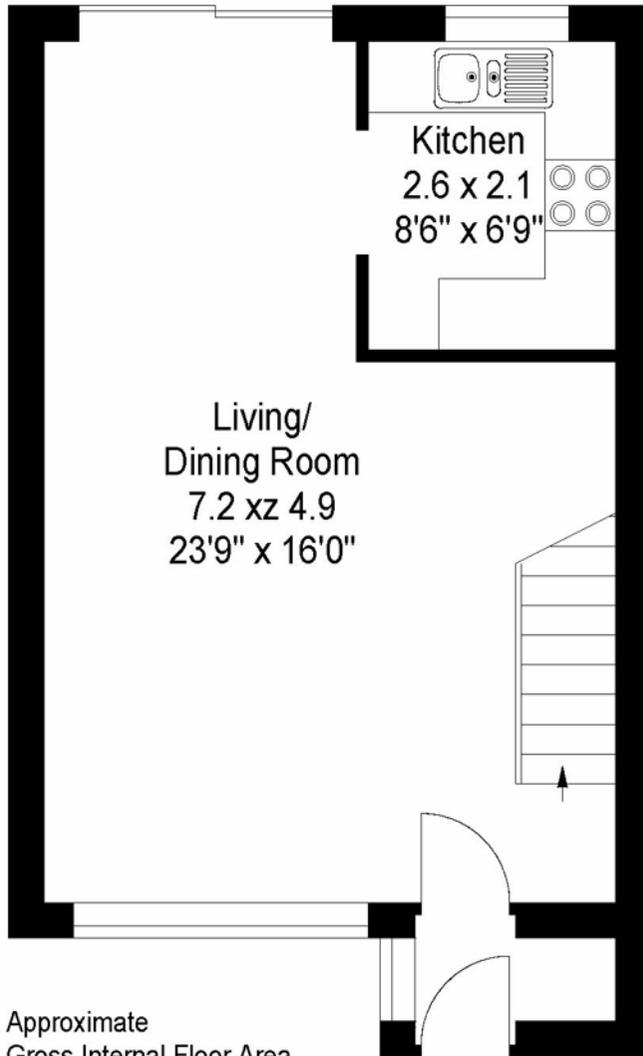
The Property

The Property Continued...

Stairs rise to the first-floor landing, giving access to all three bedrooms. The main double bedroom is bright and spacious, with a pleasant front-facing aspect and fitted cupboards. Two further bedrooms, one with fitted storage, share a modern family bathroom complete with a shower.



Grounds & Gardens

The property enjoys a private and secluded garden to the front of the property. The garden is laid mainly to lawn with a colourful raised bed and mature plantings and a small patio area. There is a garage underneath the property which is accessed to the back of the town houses with ample private communal parking.



Both Lymington and Brockenhurst afford fine schooling (both state and private) with the latter having a tertiary college.

Situation

Situated within walking distance of the beautiful market town of Lymington, with its cosmopolitan shopping and picturesque harbour within easy reach. Lymington has a number of independent shops including some designer boutiques and is surrounded by the outstanding natural beauty of the New Forest National Park. To the north is the New Forest village of Lyndhurst and Junction 1 of the M27, which links to the M3 for access to London. There is also a branch line train link to Brockenhurst railway station (5.5 mile s) which offers a half hourly service to London Waterloo with a journey time of approximately 90 minutes.

From our office in the High Street, turn left and take the first left turning into New Street (between Boots and Costa) at the end of this road turn left and immediately right into Lower Buckland Road. Continue for half a mile and the property can be found on the right hand side.
