




Ground Floor

'Gathering Moss', Lower Stone, Berkeley, Gloucestershire GL13 9DP

What a stunning location! This beautiful woodland plot provides privacy and seclusion in a delightful rural setting - south-facing to the rear, neighbours on both sides and open farmland behind. It is a haven for wildlife - on the day these pictures were taken, a Spotted Woodpecker was surprised on the garden table and a Roe Deer was keeping an eye on things from the trees before disappearing into the foliage. Overall, circa 0.77 acres of sweeping lawned gardens dotted with wildflowers and, at this time of year, a carpet of bluebells providing a deep wash of colour. The bungalow was built we understand in the 1960's, by the current family. Although now in need of a full refurbishment and possible reconstruction, it offers the template of what would have originally been quite a cutting-edge design. A vaulted 'Scandinavian'-style and openplan living space provides the heart to this unique property. There is a concealed kitchen area at the front, space for dining, plus open seating space in front of the wood-burning stove with full-width glazing and doors that overlook the rear garden. High level windows allow shafts of light to beam down from above. It is set well back from the country lane in front, along a gravelled driveway with plenty of parking, plus an attached garage and a useful office/work room behind. There are four bedrooms plus a family shower room, a utility space and a cloakroom just inside the front door. Windows are wooden triple-glazed and we understand the original underfloor heating system is electric (untested). This is a fantastic opportunity for those with imagination to create their own home in a 'one-off' setting - something and somewhere rarely available. The family hope someone new will enjoy and cherish it just as much as they have, making their home there for years to come. (Please call to discuss in more detail prior to booking viewings). N.B. Situation

The hamlet of Lower Stone is situated 4.7 miles to the north-east of Thornbury High Street, away from main roads & motorways yet just 2 miles from J14 of the M5. An accessible rural setting with all the byways of the Berkeley Vale right on the door step. Along the same lane, the neighbouring village of Rockhampton has St Oswald's church with its 14th Century tower and a thriving cricket club - www.rockhamptoncc.com. The nearest secondary school is The Castle School in Thornbury - www.thecastleschool.org.uk and to the north lies the historic town of Berkeley with its medieval castle.
