



Maple House | Thrimby



MAPLE HOUSE

Tucked away along quiet lanes between Thrimby and Great Strickland, Maple House is an exceptionally spacious and characterful country home set within approximately 2.5 acres of land, offering privacy, versatility and far-reaching rural views.

The main entrance, traditionally used as the everyday entrance, opens directly into the kitchen via a porcelain tiled pathway. The house is beautifully constructed in local stone with lime pointing, giving a soft, authentic appearance.

The first floor offers four bedrooms, and the fifth is located on the ground floor. One en suite double bedroom enjoys garden and fell views and features a deep window seat and a contemporary en suite shower room. The principal bedroom is a particularly impressive space, accommodating a super-king bed and enjoying elevated east-facing views, with a modern en suite shower room finished to a high standard. Adjacent to the ensuite is a stunning walk in wardrobe which negates the need to floor standing furniture, giving the room an open and spacious feel,

Three further bedrooms provide excellent flexibility, including one currently arranged as a single room with deep built-in storage that could be removed to create a larger double. The family bathroom serves the remaining bedrooms and is well appointed with bath, mixer shower, pedestal basin and additional storage.

LOCATED IN THE PARISH OF GREAT STRICKLAND, THIS AREA OFFERS A CLOSE KNIT, WARM COMMUNITY THE THRIVES ON THE FARMING RURAL COUNTY LIFESTYLE. HISTORICALLY PART OF WESTMORLAND, GREAT STRICKLAND IS SITUATED BETWEEN THE CUMBRIAN MOUNTAINS TO THE WEST AND THE PENNINES TO THE EAST.

THE VILLAGE IS LOCATED ON THE EDEN VALLEY CIRCULAR CYCLE ROUTE. POPULAR LOCAL WALKS INCLUDE LOOPS TOWARD THE RIVER LEITH AND NEARBY LOWTHER CASTLE PERFECT FOR THOSE WHO ENJOY THE OUTDOORS AND LOVE THE ACTIVE SIDE OF COUNTRY LIFE.
