





Sunnyside, Wotton Crescent, Wotton-under-Edge, Gloucestershire GL12 7JZ

There is no more fitting a name than 'Sunnyside' for this beautiful, elevated detached family home. Discreetly positioned toward the end of Wotton Crescent, with a no-through road position renowned for its far-reaching views across the rooftops of Wotton-under-Edge and the hills of the Cotswold Escarpment. Though tranguil and secluded, it lies a gentle stroll from Wotton's historic High Street. Set behind barn-style gates, this handsome home is found on grounds of approximately 0.309 acres, framed by the beautiful scenery of fields and Warren Woods behind. Mature, well-tended gardens create a tapestry of flowers, trees and shrubs. Towards the end, a delightful summer house perfectly captures the setting sun over the town, while a vegetable garden is found at the very rear. Inside, the home offers a thoughtful and flexible layout, which has been adapted to allow a long-standing residence throughout life. A practical boot room leads you into the home, connecting to a downstairs shower room conveniently placed after muddy countryside walks on the nearby Cotswold Way. A welcoming entranceway leads to a bright and well-appointed kitchen with plenty of storage and work surface space, overlooking the garden. Adjacent to the kitchen, a handy utility room with access to the rear leads to the integral garage. The ground floor also features an impressive sitting room with a feature fireplace and French doors opening onto one of two seating areas, flooding the room with natural light. A further two reception rooms offer space for formal dining, a snug, a playroom or a second office, with the first connecting from the entrance hall. Upstairs, a generous landing leads to four bedrooms – three of which are generous doubles. The principal bedroom enjoys far-reaching views and is served by its own en-suite shower room. The rest of the rooms are serviced by the family bathroom, consisting of a white suite. 'Sunnyside' is a residence suited to those looking for countryside calm with a connection to the friendly community of Wotton-under-Edge.

Situation

This charming market town enjoys a vibrant High Street with an eclectic mix of independent shops and cafes, complemented by two well-known supermarkets – it even has its own cinema! Wotton-under-Edge (M5 J14 approx 5.1 miles) is situated amidst beautiful countryside on the edge of the Cotswold escarpment – the Cotswold way runs straight through, perfect for walkers. Tetbury (approx. 10.1 miles), Cirencester, Bristol, Cheltenham make it an ideal location for families, commuters and outdoor enthusiasts. 
