




Ground Floor

This detached family home has a modern open-plan layout on the ground floor, bringing you into an attractive kitchen/diner with space for dining which opens out to a light and bright living room which benefits from two sets of glazed French doors that open onto the wrap around garden (front and side only). You will also find a bright entrance hall and a downstairs WC which also houses a utility cupboard for a washing machine and a dryer, plus there is the bonus of a fitted downstairs shower. The first floor is flooded with light - courtesy of the large skylight on the landing - from where you will find two double bedrooms, then a single bedroom and a modern family bathroom with shower over the bath. The outside space has been divided into off street parking to the front and a wrap around side garden which is laid to a small lawn and patio. In summary a new built home that is all ready to go!

Situation

The town of Yate is located approximately 5.8 miles from the M4 Junction 18 and 11.3 miles from the centre of Bristol. It has a train station with main line connections, a refurbished leisure centre, retail park including cinema and restaurants and a large shopping centre which caters for all needs. From Yate there is easy access to Chipping Sodbury with its historic High Street dating back to the 12th Century. Chipping Sodbury offers a wide and eclectic range of shops and established businesses and a Waitrose store which has been built in the centre of the town. There is a selection of both Primary and Secondary Schooling in the Yate area of good reputation plus there is the open green spaces of Westerleigh Common. Chipping Sodbury also offers country walks on its own common which neighbours the golf course, rugby and cricket club.


