A 4 bedroom, 2 en-suite detached barn conversion situated in a rural location in grounds of approximately 3/4 of an acre, subject to survey, with fields to the rear.

DESCRIPTION

GROUND FLOOR

Upon entering the tiled entrance hall, you are welcomed into a cloakroom before reaching the principal bedroom, which benefits from an en-suite shower room. The sitting room has a brick fireplace with wood-burning stove and double doors leading through to a good-sized conservatory.

From the opposite side of the entrance hall is the fully fitted kitchen/dining room with central island. Off the kitchen is a useful utility/boot room and an inner hallway giving access to the main family bathroom with shower. There are three further bedrooms (1 en-suite), along with a spacious family/TV room.

OUTSIDE

The property occupies a plot extending to approximately 3/4 of an acre, subject to survey, and is approached via a five-bar. The front garden is predominantly laid to lawn, complemented by a section of hedging along the front boundary. To the rear, the property features a brick-weave area and decked area which back onto open fields.

SITUATION

Clenchwarton is a thriving Norfolk village in the heart of the fens, only a few miles from King's Lynn, with good bus links into the town. The village offers a range of clubs and organisations, as well as a post office, general store, a public house, children's play area, playing field and a good primary school. King's Lynn is a very interesting town, from the much filmed old medieval centre around St Margaret's Church to the newly redeveloped and pedestrianised Vancouver Shopping Centre. The town has good schools, the Queen Elizabeth II Hospital, large and small supermarkets and many superstores, restaurants, a ten-pin bowling alley, swimming pool, library, and a cinema. There is a mainline rail link via Cambridge to London King's Cross - approximately 1hr 40 mins.

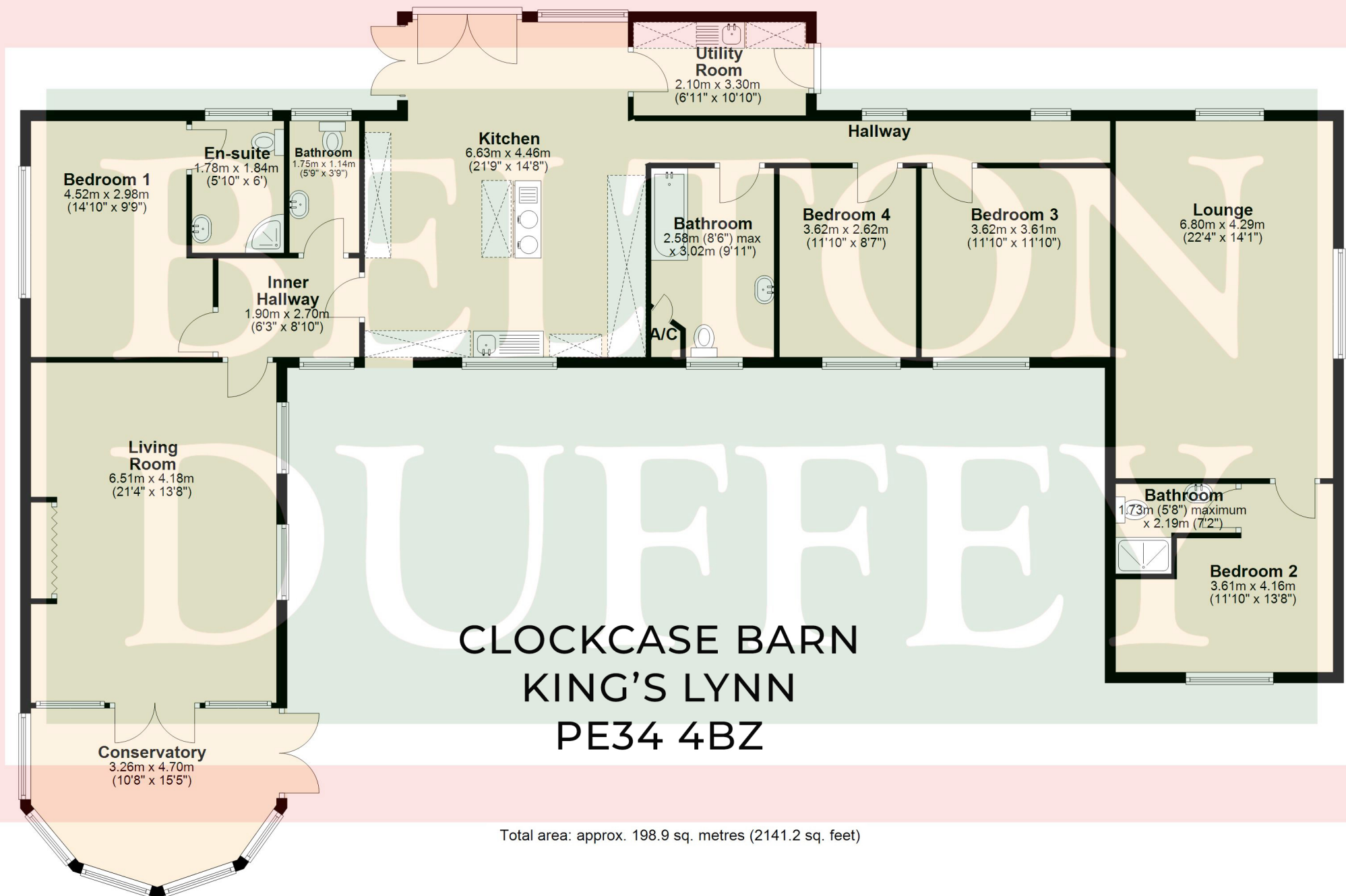
