There is ample storage available, including the loft space. Externally, the property is maintained by the management under the terms of the lease agreement. Management service charges are currently £267.00 per month – there is no ground rent. Plenty of unallocated parking is available, and there are garages that can be rented (there may be a waiting list). Private and attractive communal grounds make a pleasant background. The old farmhouse itself is home to a communal sitting room, kitchen space, and facilities. Noteworthy nearby highlights include The Three Horseshoes bistro pub, Bickerdikes Garden Centre and café / restaurant, and the beautiful 13.2 mile Letchworth Greenway for walking, cycling or running.

Transport links are excellent – A1(M) junction 9 (North & South), A507 leading to M1 are within easy reach. Trains run from Baldock, Letchworth and Arlesey stations to London Kings Cross / St Pancras, while London Luton Airport is a 40 minute drive, and London Stanstead around 45 minutes. The cultural offering of Cambridge is also just 40 minutes drive away.
