Location

Ideally situated in a prime Maidenhead location and close to a number of good schools including Newlands Girls School. The property is just over 2 miles from Maidenhead Train Station which forms part of Crossrail and a short distance to the A404 providing access to the M4 and M40. Maidenhead is a large town in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead, in Berkshire which is currently undergoing huge regeneration within the town centre. Maidenhead is a busy commuter town with excellent road and rail links making it a sought after location for businesses. Maidenhead train station is served by local services operated by First Great Western from London Paddington to Reading, and is also the junction for the Marlow Branch Line.

Sports And Leisure

There are numerous local sports clubs including tennis, rugby, rowing and football, various fitness centres and racing at Ascot and Windsor. The River Thames can also be accessed at Maidenhead Riverside with many walks to be enjoyed along the Thames Path. The local area has many walking trails, including the National Trust woodland at Maidenhead Thicket and Pinkneys Green. Nearby amenities include golf, an indoor swimming pool and Braywick Leisure centre, a multiplex cinema, shops and restaurants.


