Location

Speldhurst is one of the most sought after villages situated on the fringes of Tunbridge Wells. The property is within walking distance of the 'new' local village shop, to include a post office. The well respected Junior School and the very popular village recreation ground which is favourable with families of all ages is also only a short walk from the property. In the summer it is host to local cricket matches and all are welcome. There is an annual Summer Fayre where all the villagers get involved in creating a magnificent event for all age groups. Properties like this rarely come to market as villagers tend to remain within this area for many years. There are good rail links from Hildenborough, Tonbridge or High Brooms, to London MLS within a short drive from this property. This picturesque village also boasts a magnificent church and one of the oldest pubs in the South East, both being served well by the local community. Speldhurst is fringed with some stunning countryside walks which are popular with families, dog walkers and ramblers.

One Floor

Hallway

A double built-in cupboard for storage. Wall mounted consumer unit. Hanging space for hats and coats. Loft hatch. Pull down concertina style fixed ladder. Fully boarded loft. Power connected. Gas boiler (12 years old).



Family Bathroom/Wet Room

Window to rear. Tiled flooring. Corner shower cubicle with wall mounted gravity shower unit.

Bath, WC to match. Fully integrated wash basin with built in deep drawer below. Wall mounted chrome ladder styles radiator. Extractor fan. Recessed halogen ceiling spotlights.

Kitchen

Window to rear. Tiled flooring. Wood effect work top housing a four ring electric hob and extractor fan above. Built-in eye level electric double oven and grill. Integrated fridge-freezer, dishwasher and washing machine. Stainless steel sink and drainer. A breakfast area with space for a table and chairs. An attractive range of eye level and base units.

Living Room

Open plan through to Conservatory. Recessed ceiling halogen spotlights. Wall lights.

Conservatory

Glass vaulted roof. Double fully glazed patio doors through to rear garden. Custom made blinds to remain.

Main Bedroom

Bay window to front with deep shelf. Built-in triple wardrobe (to remain).



Bedroom Two

Currently used as a dining room. Window to front.

Outside

Front Garden

A large paved driveway for parking. A generous area of lawn with picket fence surround.

Rear Garden

A good sized paved patio flanked with a low brick wall and steps up to a level lawn. Side gated access to front. Wooden fence panel surround with flower beds housing mature shrubs and trees. Outside hose and outside lighting.
