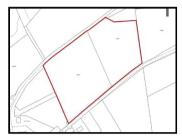

The land is situated on the edge of the coastal village of Plwmp on the A487 offering village shop and post office with good public transport connectivity. The nearby Synod Inn and Brynhoffnant offer primary school, petrol stations and post office. The Cardigan Bay coastline is within a 10 minutes drive at the sandy coves of New Quay, Cwmtydu and Llangrannog.

GENERAL

The land enjoys roadside frontage to both sides along the A487 and from the adjoining quiet country lane.

The land has mature hedgerow and well fenced boundaries to all sides, ideal for stock keeping.

The land sits on the edge of the village and medium to long term potential for development (stc) and also ideal as a diversification project with good roadside connectivity and access to public transport.

The land is set within the Cardigan Bay early growing region enjoying a south facing aspect and has been well farmed over recent years.

The land presents itself as an excellent add on to any agricultural enterprises in the local vicinity.

It is also considered that this land would be an excellent and convenient parcel for those with equestrian interests with the potential to erect stables, menage/arena (stc).

The land may also have conservation potential.















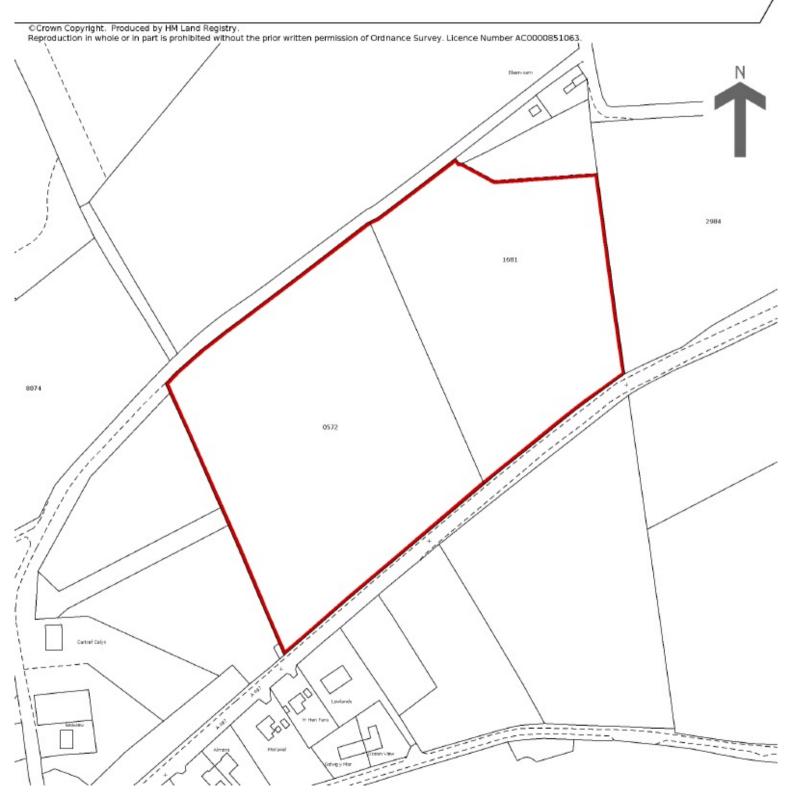

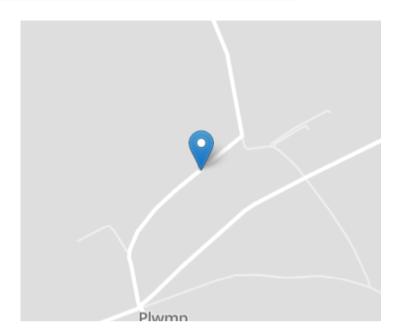

Directions

Travelling south from Synod Inn on the main A487, proceed through Gwenlli (church with white railings on crossroads) and continue south. Having navigated around a sharp bend proceed for a further half a mile until you reach a crossroads (if you reach Plwmp you have gone too far). Take the right hand turning at the crossroads sign posted Cwmtydu and proceed around the chicane, taking the left hand exit adjoining a white cottage. Proceed up the road and access to the land is the first on the left hand side as identified by the agents for sale board.
