

Grade II Listed 2 bedroom cottage designed by Arts & Crafts Architect Geoffrey Lucas and completed in 1905 as one of a pair of rural workers cottages in the early phase of the Letchworth Garden City development. Croft Lane predates the Garden City development being part of the village of Norton. The property is within easy walking distance of open countryside as well as Letchworth Train Station. The property has North Herts Planning & Listed Building consent (subject to conditions) to extend. The Vendor is currently awaiting final approval from the Letchworth Garden City Heritage Foundation.



- Grade II Listed Character Cottage.
- Set on the very edge of Letchworth down a quiet country lane.
- Within walking distance of open countryside.
- Letchworth Train station is also within easy walking distance.

- Planning Consent and Listed Building Consent (subject to conditions) for a two storey side and a single storey rear extension.






