## Description

Spacious four-bedroom home, purpose-built by the current owner in 2004, combining modern comforts with functional design, with easy-maintenance garden and patio, situated in a central village location, with driveway parking and single garage.

Grovesbury is in the heart of Mark village, conveniently located close to the village post office and store. The house offers versatile accommodation with two of the double bedrooms on the ground floor, sharing a bathroom with shower, and the other two on the first floor, sharing a shower room. The main living areas are at the back of the house looking out over the terrace and kitchen garden. The open-plan kitchen and dining area provide plenty of space for dining table, breakfast table and other furniture. The kitchen is fitted with a modern range of warm wooden wall and base units with contrasting work surfaces, with an electric Leisure range cooker. There is further storage and space for appliances in the adjoining utility with access to a useful WC, and a door to the side passage. The well-proportioned sitting room has an inglenook style fireplace with a log burning

stove. At the top of the stairs, the landing provides space for a study area. There are two large double bedrooms, one either side of the landing and shower room. The largest of the two is currently used as a games room, easily housing a table tennis table with plenty of remaining space for comfortable seating and other furniture. This room has the potential to be split into two bedrooms if needed. There is access to extensive eaves storage from the other bedroom.

#### Outside

The property is bordered by attractive stone walling with a five-bar gate opening onto the driveway which provides plenty of parking space and access to the garage. There are paved passageways either side of the property to the rear garden which has been designed to make the most of the sun and views to the church. Paved patio runs across the back of the house where there are French doors opening out from the kitchen and living space. Raised boarders are thoughtfully planted to provide attractive colour and texture, whilst a productive kitchen garden and greenhouse is screened behind trellis and hedging.


