

Flat 21, Rockwood House Gravel Hill Road, Yate BS37 7BW

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Rockwood House was originally a small country park (formerly 'Yate House') which was restored in 1990 with lavish well maintained grounds and wonderful communal garden space for the residents. Flat 21 is beautifully presented and modernised with fitted wardrobes, replaced kitchen and modern bathroom. It is in a modern building to the rear of the original house and occupies a top (2nd) floor position with the fantastic advantage of a far reaching view beyond the Severn estuary to the Welsh hills where you can appreciate the setting sun on an evening. The flat itself has a light, bright South/Westerly aspect plus a picturesque outlook over the lawns and across the grand entrance of the main building. The apartment will suit those looking for a stylish lifestyle out of the city with countryside surrounds, yet on the cusp of Chipping Sodbury's bustling High Street and the shops in Yate town centre.

Situation

The town of Yate is located approximately 5.8 miles from the M4 Junction 18 and 11.3 miles from the centre of Bristol, so excellent for commuting. It has a train station with main line connections to Bristol Parkway and Temple Meads, a refurbished leisure centre, retail park, restaurants and a large shopping centre which caters for all needs. From Yate there is easy access to the nearby market town of Chipping Sodbury with its historic High Street dating back to the 12th Century. Chipping Sodbury offers a wide and eclectic range of shops and businesses plus a Waitrose store which is found in the centre of the town. There is a selection of both Primary and Secondary Schooling in the Yate area of good reputation plus there are the open green spaces on Westerleigh Common. Chipping Sodbury also offers country walks on its own common which neighbours the golf course, rugby, tennis and cricket club.
