your area. They're not your energy supplier and they don't bill you. They can help with things like connecting your home to power, moving your meter, registering you for the Priority Services Register (customers/extra-help-for-customers) or assisting you if there's a power cut.

If you have a problem with your direct debit or your energy bill, you'll need to speak to your energy supplier. Their details can be found on your bill.

What's an energy network operator?

The energy networks are like a system of roads that transport electricity and gas from where it's made to homes and businesses. Transmission lines and pipes carry electricity and gas over long distances, and distribution lines bring it to individual places. Network operators look after these wires and pipes. If there's a problem, like a power cut, they work to fix it. Their job is crucial for keeping our lights on and making sure we have a reliable supply of electricity and gas.

Independent Distribution Network Operators

Some homes and businesses are connected to **independent** distribution networks. An Independent Distribution Network Operator (IDNO) takes care of a smaller part of the electricity network. Imagine the whole electricity network as a big web connecting power stations and wind farms to homes. Regular network operators manage most of it, but an IDNO focuses on specific areas, ensuring that electricity flows smoothly in those particular places. So, while the main network operators handle the overall "web", IDNOs specialise in making sure certain neighbourhoods or communities get the power they need without any hiccups. You can find a list of those operators below.
