

Situated just under half a mile of the Wokingham Market Place and rail station, a smartly presented ground floor maisonette set in an over 55's retirement development built in the 1980's. The property has its own personal front door yet enjoys the benefits of all the communal facilities. The 439 sq ft of accommodation comprises hallway, living room, newly refitted kitchen, bedroom and shower/wet room. The property has uPVC double glazing, electric heating and an EPC rating of C. To the front is a communal car park with spaces for residents and visitors and to the rear is an established, beautifully presented communal garden with a well-tended lawn area, mature trees, pond, water feature, outside lighting and seating area. Within the development there is a community room, a lift and a communal laundry room. Lease details 99 years from July 26th 2022 (new owners receive a new lease to 99 years on purchase), service charge for 1st April 2025 to 31st March 2026 £2,648.87 and no ground rent. On surrender of the lease there will be a charge of 2.5% of the sale price plus 0.5% of the sale price for every year that you have owned the property.
