

This property requires some updating however benefits from both gas central heating and majority double glazing. In brief comprises of an entrance hall with side entrance door and stairs to the first floor. Lounge with feature period circular window to the side, living flame gas fire and double doors opening into a rear porch. Kitchen Diner with a range of wall and base units, worktops, sink, recess cupboards, understairs cupboard, windows to the rear and side elevations. First Floor - Landing, Three Bedrooms and a Bathroom comprising of a bath, w.c., and wash basin. Outside, gardens to the front and rear, pathway to the side. EPC Rating D
