
Ground Floor - Entrance Hall with understairs cupboard. Living Room with bay window to the front elevation. Dining Room - Open to; Kitchen - With a range of wall and base units with laminate worktop, stainless steel sink unit and tiled splashback. Electric oven, gas hob, plumbing for washing machine. Utility Room/Store - with Base unit with stainless steel sink unit, laminate worktop and plumbing for washing machine.

First Floor - Landing - Bedroom One with built-in storage. Bedroom Two with built-in storage. Bedroom Three with built-in storage above the bulk head. Bathroom - Three piece suite comprising; low suite wc, hand basin and bath with electric shower over. Heated towel rail

Outside - The front of the property is a lawn with pathway leading to the front door.

To the rear of the property there is a paved seating area and lawn. Long distance views.
