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#### DESCRIPTION

As you enter through the front door you are welcomed into a spacious hallway with original glazed arch feature and new Herringbone oak flooring. To the left-hand side is the living room which is a generous size and has plenty of natural light. It creates a great space where you can entertain family and friends, and the electric fireplace acts as the main focal point in the room.

Across the hallway is the main bedroom which again is generous in size and the current vendor has kept the original floorboards. The second bedroom, currently used as a home office, is located at the rear of the property and enjoys views over the rear garden.

The bathroom has recently undergone a full refurbishment and has been fitted with a walk-in shower, a bath, a W.C and a wash hand basin.

The open plan kitchen and dining area is at the rear of property. Having undergone extensive refurbishment there is a range of wall and base units, an integrated oven, a four-ring gas hob and space for a fridge/freezer.

The dining area has ample space for a table and chairs and creates a wonderful space for entertaining. There is access to a rear porch and a utility room from the kitchen.

### LOCATION


