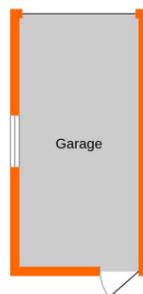
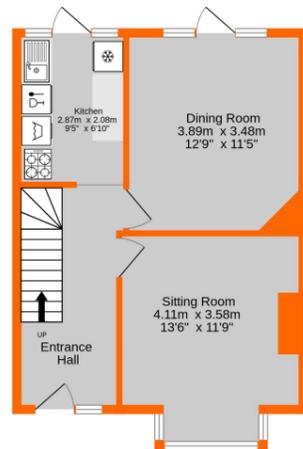
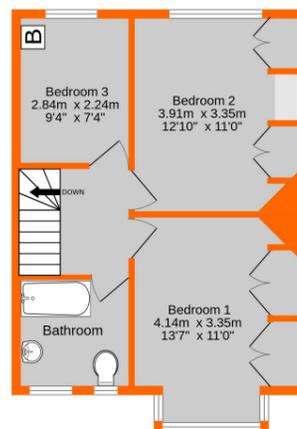

Fantastic opportunity to purchase a delightful family home with significant improvements carried out by the current owner. Recent upgrades include a full rewire and the installation of brand new central heating system, complete with new pipework, radiators and boiler (10.11.22). The property benefits from double glazing throughout, with a number of windows recently replaced. The décor is neutral and modern, creating a bright and welcoming feel. While the kitchen is well maintained and functional, some buyers may wish to update it to reflect the high standard set by the beautifully reappointed first floor family bathroom. Externally, the home offers excellent space for family living - the front garden has been prepared and is ready for planting, while the rear garden features a generous lawned area and a hardstanding space adjacent to the single garage accessed via a rear service road.

Location

Glanfield Road runs between Eden Park Avenue and Beck Way. Via Village Way, this property is less than a mile from Beckenham High Street providing a range of shops, restaurants and other amenities. An entrance to the beautiful Kelsey Park will be found on Stone Park Avenue and the popular Unicorn and Langley Park Schools are just under a mile away. Eden Park Station is about three quarters of a mile away providing trains to Charing Cross, London Bridge and Cannon Street as well as DLR connection to Canary Wharf. Beckenham Junction station is about a mile away providing trains to Victoria plus trams to Croydon and Wimbledon.
