Location

Rusthall village has become extremely desirable location with homeowners over the last few years as it has so much to offer. It sits in an area which boasts beautiful Kent countryside and there are so many country walks minutes from the property. Space for fridge freezer. A range of attractive eye level and base units for storage. A cast iron wood burner (in full working order) on a slate hearth.

Tastefully designed deluxe bathroom. Window to side with additional small window to side. Slate tiles to flooring with wall tiles to match. Fully tiled corner shower cubicle with wall mounted 'rain shower' and additional wall mounted hand held shower unit. A free standing deluxe style 'roll top bath' with ornate period style feet. Wall mounted gas combi boiler. Wash basin with WC to match. Wall mounted chrome ladder style radiator.

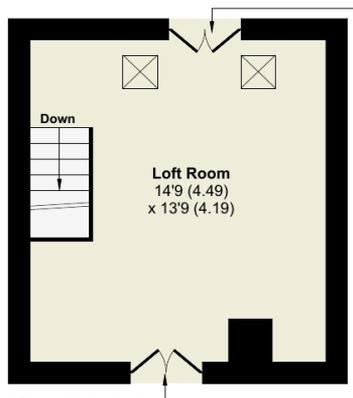

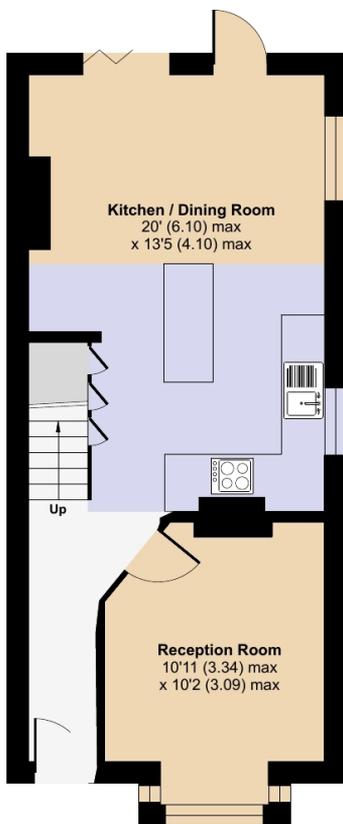

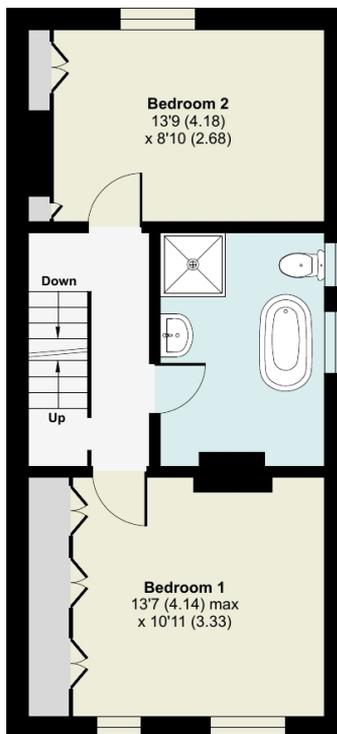
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SECOND FLOOR
