Upstairs, the home offers four double bedrooms, including a beautifully appointed principal suite with its own en-suite shower room. A luxurious four piece family bathroom serves the remaining bedrooms.

Outside, the property enjoys a private, south-facing rear garden, ideal for relaxing and entertaining, along with a detached garage and a carriage driveway providing ample offstreet parking.

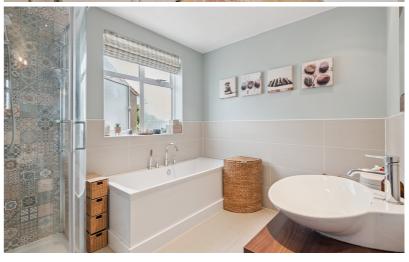

The town provides good shopping as well as a swimming pool, football team, two theatres, a wide variety of restaurants and pubs and highly regarded girls and boys schools. There is also a mainline railway station providing direct access to Kings Cross and Cambridge.

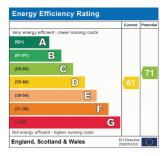
