



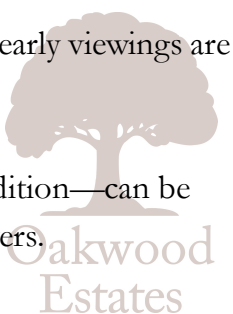

Floor Plan

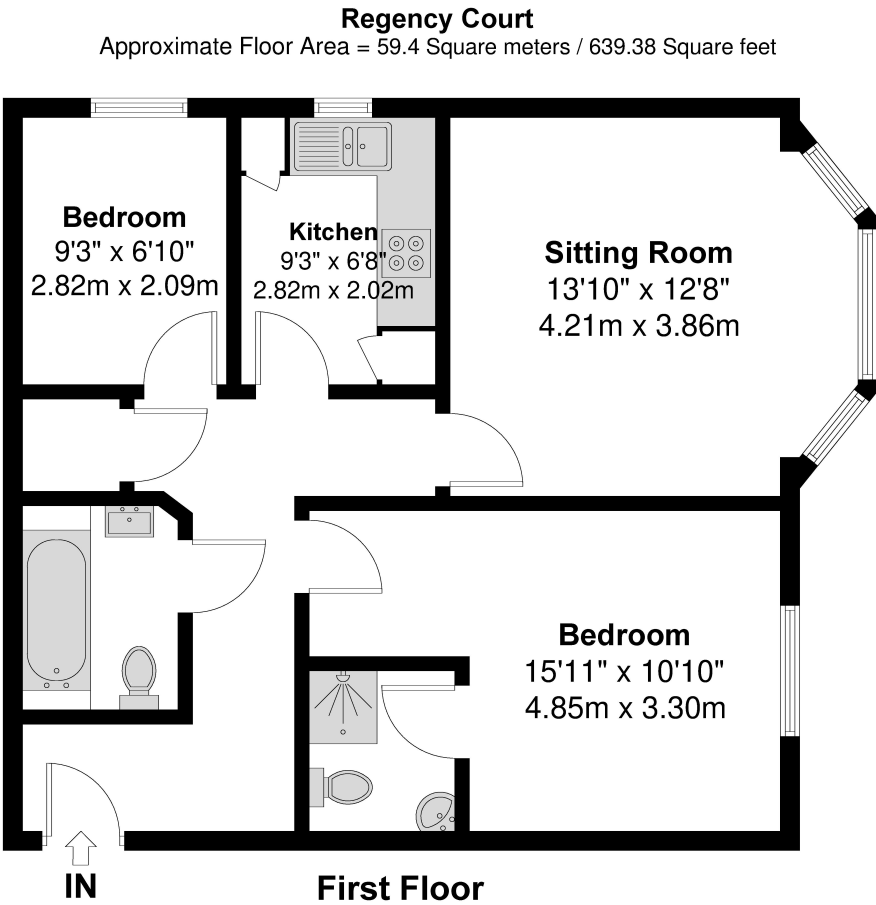
