#### Description

This property occupies a quiet spot, positioned on a nothrough road, over looking a recreational ground to the front and only a short walk from the River Thames and the town centre of Abingdon.

Internally the property provides an entrance hall, sitting room, bedroom, shower room and a kitchen. To the side is Preparatory and Our Lady's Abingdon. a store/garden room which could provide additional living space. The property does require some modernisation throughout but benefits from gas central heating and UPVC double glazed windows.

Externally to the front is an open garden area which then looks out to the recreational grounds beyond. The rear garden is private and enclosed.

The property is available to purchaser freehold and there will be no onward chain. An estate charge of approx £167 per annum is payable.










# **Ground Floor**
