











A delightful, four bedroom detached family home, situated in the ever popular village of Burley.

## The Property

Entering the property through the entrance porch through to the main hallway, which provides access to all principal reception rooms, the kitchen, a bedroom and the downstairs cloakroom. The kitchen features high and low-level cupboards, together with an island unit and integrated oven. The room offers space for a breakfast table with French doors to the terraced area at the rear of the property.

The spacious living room benefits from wooden floors throughout, a feature fireplace and a pair of French doors lead out to the garden at the rear. Further to the ground floor, a generously sized dining room also featuring wooden floors and window to the side of the property. A single bedroom or study located downstairs which benefits from an ensuite shower room.

To the first floor there are three good sized double bedrooms, all serviced by a shower room and spacious bathroom. The first floor landing provides ample storage with cupboard space from three double wardrobes.

#### Grounds and Gardens

The property is approached over a cattle grid via five bar gates, leading onto a spacious driveway. The rear garden can be accessed by a side gate situated to the left hand side of the property, where a pathway leads around to the partly raised garden which is mainly laid to lawn surrounded by planned shrubs, mature trees and hedges. This further leads down to the terraced area providing the perfect place for al fresco dining.

### **Directions**

From our office in the Village proceed in a northerly direction towards Ringwood. Upon reaching Burley Street, the property will be found on the right hand side, if you turn into The Barracks and drive down the gravel track the properties entrance can we found at the end of the road on the right hand side.















#### The Situation

Snowdrops is located in Burley Street with some of the New Forest's loveliest heathland views a short walk away. It is also close to the amenities of Burley, a honeypot New Forest village, and yet it is only a couple of minutes' drive to Picket Post on the A31. The New Forest, ideally situated to make full use of all the wonderful facilities the Forest has to offer. Whether it be sailing at nearby Lymington (12 miles) or golf at one of the many courses in the area including nearby Burley and Brockenhurst with its mainline railway station (8 miles, Waterloo 90 minutes) The market town of Ringwood is but a short drive away (5 miles). The larger shopping towns of Southampton (20 miles) to the east and Bournemouth (16 miles) to the west, both with their airports, are easily accessible.
