


Ground Floor

36 Hillesley Road, Wotton-under-Edge, Kingswood, Gloucestershire GL12 8RU

This end-terrace character-filled home is conveniently located close to shops and beautiful countryside walks. It is a short level walk to Kingswood Primary School and the prestigious Katharine Lady Berkley's Secondary School. From the front, the home opens into a handy entranceway, which continues into the comfortable lounge/diner. A sun-soaked front-facing window bathes the room in natural light, while the working wood burner takes the chill out of colder evenings. To the rear, a long kitchen features plenty of base and wall units, ideal for cooking your latest recipes, adorned by two UPVC windows and a separate door onto the rear courtyard garden. Continuing around it leads to a generous downstairs WC with the potential to be transformed into a utility space. An additional versatile room completes this floor, which could serve as an extra bedroom, office space, or children's den with a loft space above for storage. The first floor accommodates the second bedroom, featuring two built-in storage cupboards and a period fireplace and the family bathroom with a shower overhead of the bath. A further staircase leads to the principal bedroom, complete with a window overlooking the rear of the home. There is a pretty courtyard garden to the rear of the property, mainly laid with astroturf, and it accommodates a generous shed at the very rear. Complete with parking, this home is perfect for those looking for cosy cottage comfort, while remaining in the heart of a beautiful village.

Situation

The village of Kingswood is located approximately 1.2 miles South West of the market town Wotton under Edge. It allows ideal access to the Cotswolds plus has the benefit of commuting to Bristol via the M5 Junction 14 which is approximately 4.4 miles away. The village has a lovely Conservation High Street which leads to Kingswood Primary School via the historic stone (former) Abbey gateway. Plus Kingswood is in the catchment for the very popular nearby Katharine Lady Berkeley secondary school (http://www.klbschool.org.uk). In the centre of the village there is the local store and the Village Inn Public House. Also the village has its own park and playing fields
