



From Aberaeron take the A487 coast road south towards Cardigan. Continue through the villages of Ffosyffin, LLwyncelyn, Llanarth, Synod Inn, Plwmp and then onto the village of Pentregat. At the crossroads in Pentregat turn right towards Llangrannog, follow the road for approximately 2 miles, continuing through Pontgarreg and on towards Llangrannog. As you start dropping down into Llangrannog, you will see the land on your left as identified by the agents for sale board.
