# Low Mill, Caton



Low Mill in Caton, Lancashire, England, is a historic building situated on the banks of the River Lune. Originally constructed in the 18th century, Low Mill served as a cotton spinning mill during the Industrial Revolution, contributing to the area's industrial growth and economic prosperity. The mill played a significant role in the textile industry of Lancashire, which was a hub for cotton manufacturing during the 18th and 19th centuries. 























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
