WELCOME TO BIRDS CLOSE

Approaching the property, you'll find it proudly situated in the center of the terrace, overlooking expansive green spaces. Enter through the upgraded composite door into a home that has been lovingly maintained by its owners. The spacious entrance hall features a classic 50's Garden City porthole-style window, with a staircase leading to the first floor. Off the hall, the showcase kitchen breakfast room has been thoughtfully reconfigured to maximise storage and is finished with sleek white gloss units. It includes space for freestanding appliances, with an integrated oven, inset gas hob, and extractor. This room offers a rear-facing aspect, complemented by a door that leads out to the garden. Under-counter lighting and porcelain tiled flooring enhance its appeal.

The large living room features dual aspects to the front and rear, with French doors opening into the garden. The floor is elegantly finished with engineered wood.

HEAD ON UP

As you enter, a spacious landing awaits, conveniently providing access to the airing cupboard and loft. The principal bedroom and second bedroom both feature a front facing orientation and come equipped with built-in cupboards, ensuring ample storage. Bedroom three enjoys a rear facing view. The family bathroom is generously sized and includes a three-piece suite, also benefiting from a rear facing aspect.

TOUR THE GROUNDS

The south facing rear garden is a true delight. Immediately at the back, a patio provides a perfect space for outdoor relaxation. The central area of the garden is beautifully laid to lawn and features mature borders which have been carefully planted and shaped. All boundaries are enclosed, ensuring privacy, while the surrounding area extends to the playing fields. For added convenience, there is an outdoor tap. The front garden is well-presented and low-maintenance. Birds Close offers unrestricted street parking.

ABOUT WELWYN GARDEN CITY



