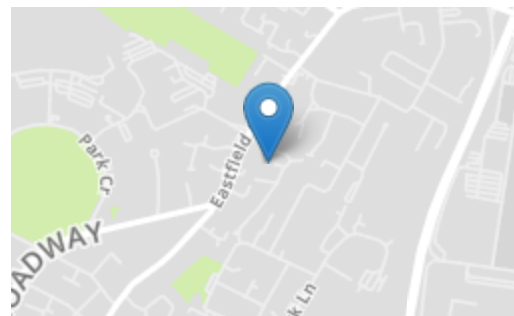
### AGENT NOTES
