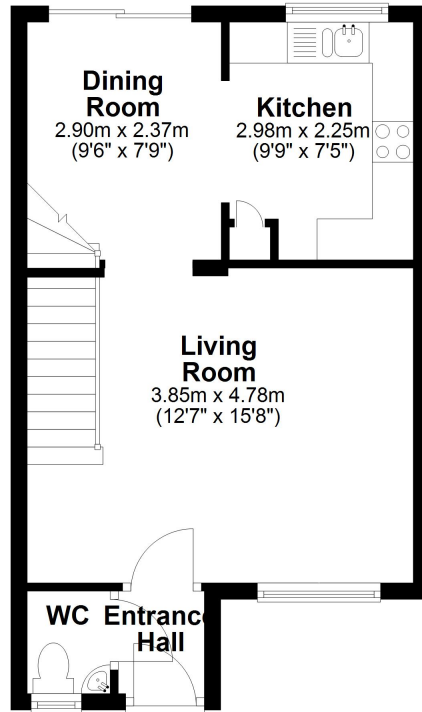

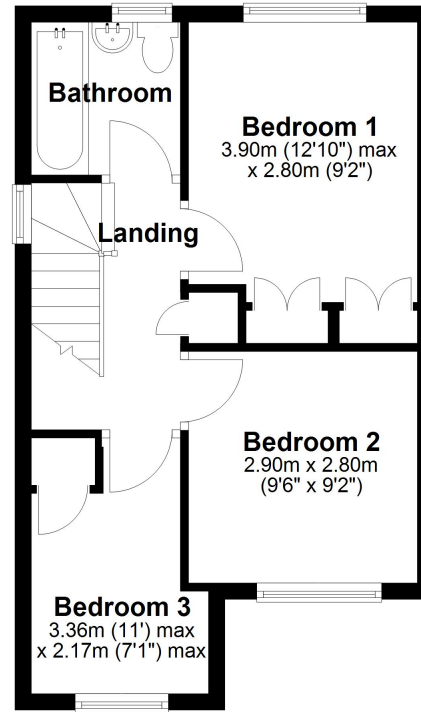
Ground Floor
