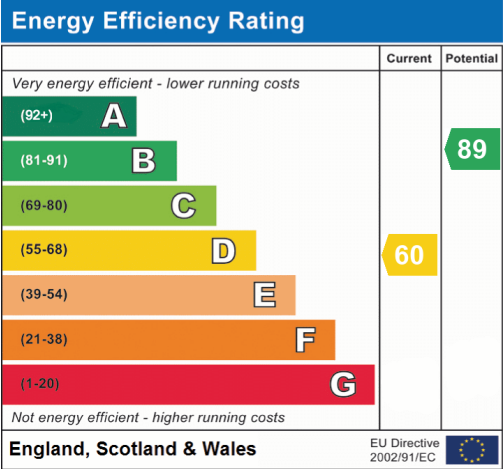
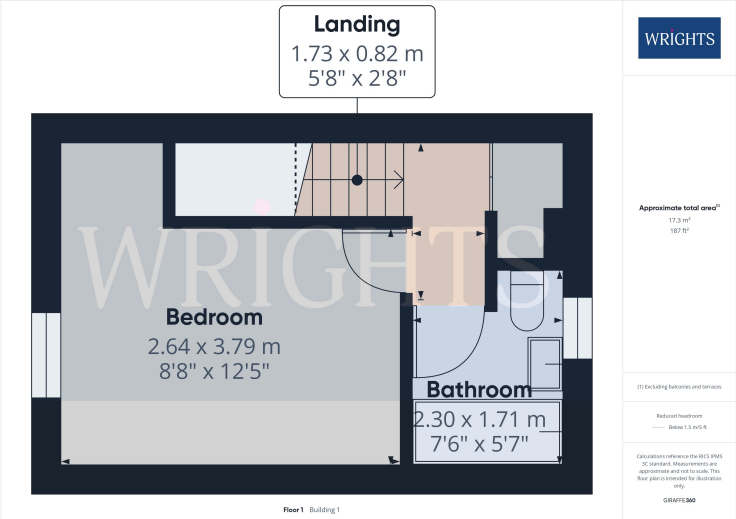
OUTSIDE
