Head on through the front door into a much loved family home. The staircase is conveniently located off the hall, providing easy access to the upper floors and there is a handy coat cupboard. This level offers superb accommodation with two spacious reception rooms connected by double doors. These rooms provide ample space for large family gatherings, featuring dedicated sitting, reading, and dining areas. The Orangery overlooks the rear garden, adding to the home's inviting atmosphere. The kitchen breakfast room, with its extensive storage options, faces the rear garden and offers a great space for family meals and casual gatherings. Up to the landing, there is an airing cupboard and loft access. From here, three bedrooms lead off.
