Built in the 1950's, this is a substantial family home which provides flexible living and can be adapted to suit a growing family. There is a separate kitchen, lounge, dining room, a large hallway with the added bonus of a ground floor w/c. In addition there is huge potential to extend the ground floor as neighboring homes have completed (subject to the usual planning consents). Upstairs there are four good size bedrooms and a generous bathroom. Large 50ft GARDEN and DRIVEWAY for two cars. Lumbards is a lovely community where most residents have resided for many years. Haldens shops are a stones throw from Lumbards. There are a selection of good local primary & secondary schools, local shopping and a good bus route into the town. Welwyn North mainline station is a 15 min walk & Welwyn Garden City is just a few minutes drive away.



ROOM DESCRIPTIONS

GROUND FLOOR

ENTRANCE HALL

A spacious and inviting entrance. The staircase leads to the first floor, there are storage facilities for coats and shoes as well as a handy w/c.

LIVING ROOM

Decorated in a grey theme, large window to the front elevation.

DINING ROOM

Perfect for large family gatherings. There is a set of patio doors plus a single door out to the rear garden. Built in storage cupboard.

KITCHEN

A superb range of walnut shaker style wall and base units. Fitted appliance to remain include, oven, inset hob, extractor and dishwasher. Pedestrian door out to the side passageway.

FIRST FLOOR

LANDING

Loft hatch access and airing cupboard housing the Worcester Bosch Combi boiler.

BEDROOM ONE

A great retreat! Spacious accommodation with the added bonus of large fitted wardrobes with mirrored doors. Window to the front elevation.

BEDROOM TWO

Another spacious bedroom with fitted cupboard. Window to the front elevation.

BEDROOM THREE

A double bedroom with views to the rear garden.

BEDROOM FOUR

A great size single bedroom, also with views over the rear garden.

FAMILY BATHROOM

A great size bathroom featuring a white suite with shower over bath, partly tiled walls and floor, for comfort there is a heated chrome towel rail and for ventilation there is a window to the rear aspect.

OUTSIDE

REAR GARDEN

A large garden with a north easterly facing aspect. mostly laid to lawn, there is a paved area to enjoy alfresco dining. The side passageway is wider than average and there is an additional passageway between the two properties making the ground floor of the home detached. Large brick built storage shed providing a great workshop space!

FRONT GARDEN

Mostly laid to lawn, there is a hedgerow to the front and path leading to the street. Large block paved driveway providing comfortable off street parking. The street offers plenty of additional unrestricted parking.


ABOUT WELWYN GARDEN CITY
