CHIVELSTONE AREA


Chivelstone is a small rural parish surrounded by lush green fields and scenic countryside as well as being equal distances between South Pool and East Prawle. The village is positioned within the southernmost tip of the South Hams and is a stones throw away from the renowned rugged coastline with its dramatic cliffs and beautiful beaches. This secluded part of Devon feels like you have stepped back to a simpler time with its close-knit community, working farms, two nearby popular pubs and a scattering of hidden away cafes. The local residents are known for their warmth and hospitality, often gathering for village events and activities. Agriculture remains a cornerstone of life here, with many of the surrounding fields actively farmed. This connection to the land adds to the village's rustic and authentic charm. The area has a long history with evidence of settlement dating back to medieval times. The village itself has several historic buildings and sites of interest.

Chivelstone is also a great base for exploring the broader South Hams area. Its proximity to the coast means that beaches and coastal paths are just a short drive away, offering plenty of opportunities for outdoor adventures. Whether you're interested in hiking, bird watching, or simply enjoying the stunning landscape

Both villages are relatively remote and are primarily accessed by narrow country roads. Public transport is limited, so having a car is usually necessary for visiting and getting around the area.
