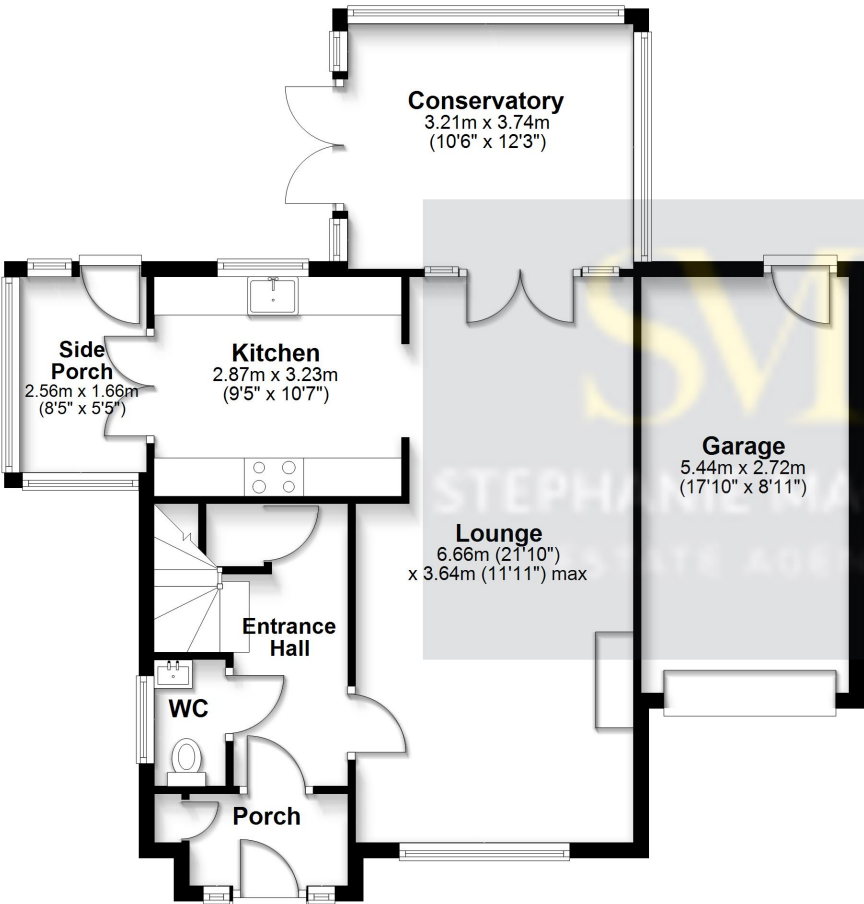

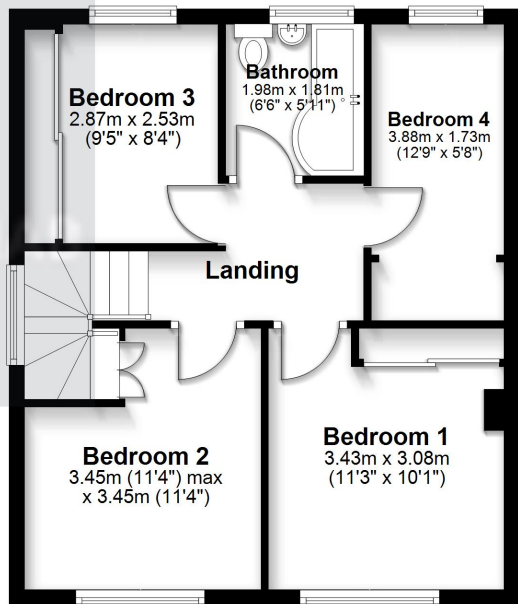
Ground Floor
