Description

Contemporary, all shiny and new, refurbished and reconfigured, gorgeous two-bedroom village bungalow with ensuite shower rooms, open-plan kitchen/dining room, separate sitting room, private rear garden, garage and parking.

Once a traditional 1970s bungalow with cavity wall insulation, it has been transformed to meet modern styles of living, opening up the smaller rooms to create larger, lighter spaces. The kitchen, with practical hard flooring throughout, is fitted with an attractive range of wall and base units topped with warm wooden work surfaces. Integrated appliances include a fridge/freezer, a dishwasher, an electric oven and an induction hob. Further space for storage and other appliances can be found in the built-in cupboard and adjoining utility room. The sitting room is a large, bright, dual aspect

room looking out on both sides to the front garden. Both double bedrooms benefit from contemporary ensuite shower rooms and they have plenty of space for bedroom furniture and storage. A spacious, central entrance hall connects all the rooms and has a handy coat and boot cupboard, a large storage cupboard which also houses the new gas boiler, and there is a modern cloakroom with WC.

The bungalow is perched on an elevated corner plot encircled by paved pathways and terraces, with lawns to the front bordered by low stone walling and a gated driveway leading to a single garage. Secure, gated access on both sides of the property open to paved pathways to the back garden which is mainly laid to lawn and is a lovely, private space.







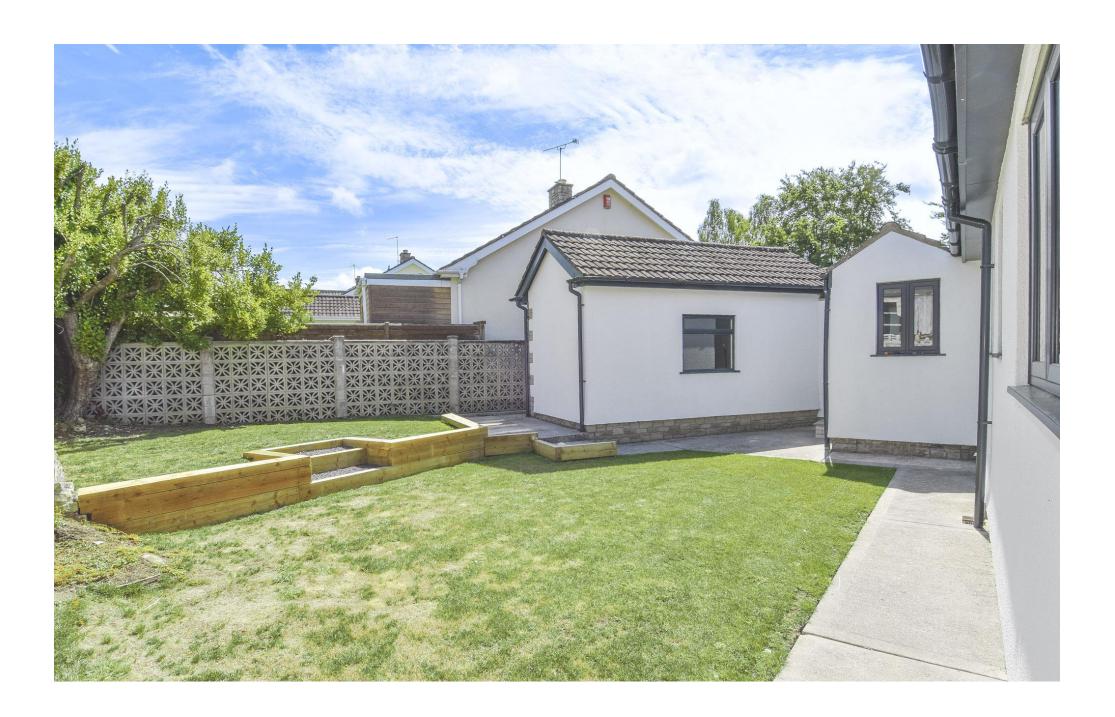

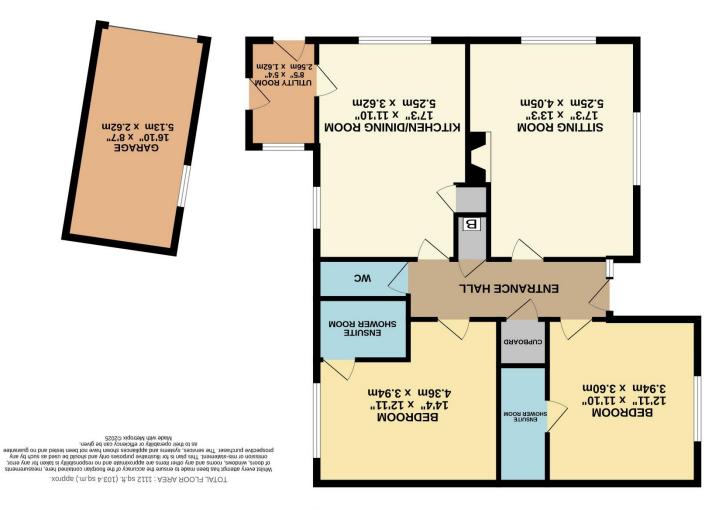
