ABOUT WELWYN GARDEN CITY

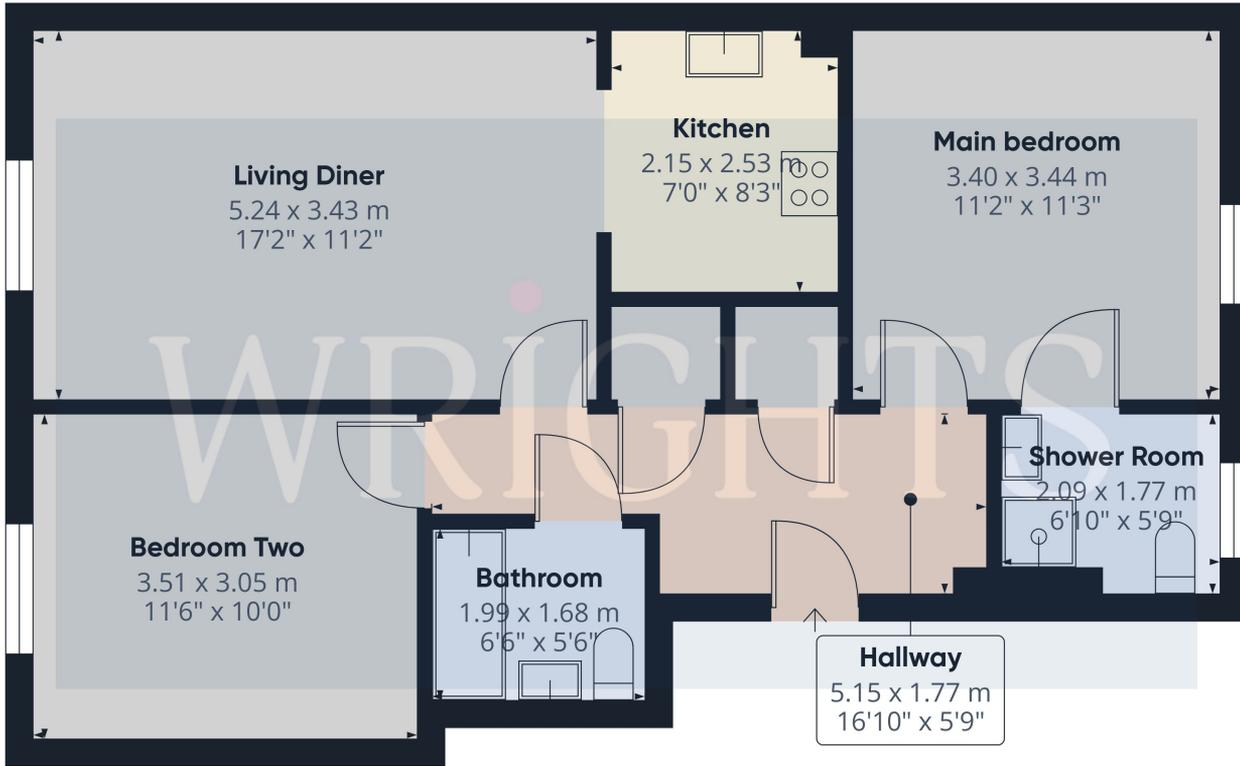
