Accommodation comprises of grand and welcoming entrance hall with stairs leading up to the first level. There is a fabulous dining room with working fireplace and English oak flooring, the sitting room is a beautiful room also with sash windows, English oak flooring and fireplace. In addition to there is a breakfast room with original quarry tiles, cast iron fire surround and open fire. This quaint and sociable room also has sash windows and door leading out to the rear garden.



Upstairs:
