Exterior & Approach

This attractive home features a half-brick, half-white render façade with a covered storm porch above the double-glazed front door. The front garden is neatly laid to lawn with manicured borders of shrubs, trees, and bushes, while the silver-grey marble chipping driveway offers off-road parking for up to three vehicles and includes an electric car charging point.

Ground Floor

Upon entering, the pristine neutral décor and newly fitted oak flooring create an immediate sense of warmth and style. The hallway includes a large storage cupboard for coats and shoes, along with a modern downstairs cloakroom.

The stunning kitchen is fitted with a range of white gloss wall and base units, complemented by solid oak worktops and a tiled floor. Integrated appliances include a tall fridge, tall freezer, dishwasher, and washing machine, along with wall-mounted double ovens incorporating a microwave/grill, an induction hob, and a matching extractor hood.

The spacious living/dining room spans the full depth of the property, benefitting from dual-aspect windows, a bay window to the front, and sliding doors opening onto the rear garden. The continuation of the oak flooring enhances the sense of flow throughout the ground floor,
