

A beautifully remodelled and secluded detached home, set in an idyllic semi-rural location within the ever-popular village of Throop. Just moments from Throop Mill and miles of picturesque riverside walks along the Stour, the property also enjoys excellent convenience with Castlepoint Shopping Centre less than 2 miles away and Bournemouth town centre — with its array of shops, restaurants, and awardwinning beaches — approximately 4 miles distant. An internal viewing is strongly recommended to fully appreciate the quality and style on offer.

On entering, a spacious hallway with oak flooring leads to all ground floor accommodation and stairs rising to the first floor. To the front, a bright living room features a charming bay window and log burner, while a versatile reception room/bedroom four is positioned to the side, served by a superbly re-fitted shower room with oversized enclosure, WC and wash basin. At the heart of the home lies an extended kitchen/dining/family room with oak flooring, remote control stove and bifolding doors opening onto the rear decked area and garden. The kitchen is fitted with an extensive range of units, quartz work surfaces and a suite of integrated NEFF appliances including double oven, induction hob, fridge/freezer, dishwasher and wine cooler. From the family space, a door connects to an impressive boot room with bespoke integrated storage and a door onto the front of the property.

Upstairs, the landing gives access to three double bedrooms and a family bathroom. The primary suite overlooks the rear garden and boasts a vaulted ceiling, large wardrobe, and luxuriously appointed en-suite shower room. Bedrooms two and three are both doubles with integrated wardrobes feature vaulted ceilings, while the main bathroom is fitted with a stylish suite including bath, WC and wash basin.

Outside, the property boasts a generous and secluded rear garden with a sunny southerly aspect. A raised terrace with electric awning adjoins the house, perfect for outdoor dining and entertaining, while the remainder is laid to lawn and framed by beautifully mature planting. To the rear, there are multiple seating areas together with an impressive garden room, currently arranged as a cinema room but equally well-suited as a home office or further accommodation. The garden also benefits from a spacious workshop and shed. To the front, a spacious driveway provides ample off-road parking.

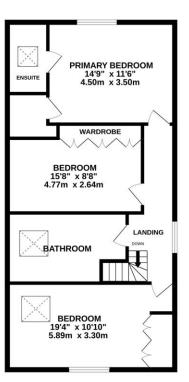
